



ACTIVITY REPORT OF NAGPUR HOUSES OF MARY IMMACULATE DURING THE FINANCIAL YEAR 2014-15

In our boarding we admit the girls from poor economic background in order to facilitate to give them basic education up to 10th standard. They are provided with good food, medical care and clothing if needed and education. The students who are weak in studies paid more attention and coaching class is given to them. This year there are 64 students in our boarding

Social Activities



Various programs are conducted for empowerment of women especially the village women.

One of the programs is training the village women the methodology of teaching by our sisters in the center and give them job in the Supplementary Classes conducted in the villages. Every teacher teach the students for 2 hours. They are also given awareness of various Government schemes in order to help the people in the villages by centre and by resource persons. Teachers have monthly evaluation at Centre on performance and the improvement of the students in their study and village work done by teacher in the tribal village.

Medical

Through our medical apostolate we are able to reach out to the indigent and weaker section patients and have given them free and concessional rate operations, medicine and other services. Patients from far away villages come to our health centers for treatment. In our health centers patients are not only treated but given the health education and awareness programme regarding communicable diseases like AIDS, Tuberculosis, Water Borne Diseases, Personal & Environmental Hygien etc..



Asha Bhavan is the only established Nursing Home we have in our Province where we have facilities for Gynaec treatments, Surgery, Sonography and Pathology. Since its foundation this centre provides prenatal and postnatal care for all women irrespective of their class, caste and creed. We give awareness programs on Sacredness of life, encourage promoting and

nurturing life from its very conception and importance of various exercises in order to keep oneself healthy. We give awareness programs to the antenatal patients in the OPD on Exercises, Herbal Medicines, Home remedies, and HIV/AIDS. Poor and marginalized patients receive free treatment or on concessional rate depending on their financial situation. In all our health centers we pay more attention to the poor and needy.
